LAPTOPS FOR ONLINE LEARNING

For the remainder of the school year, TESD students will be learning from home using technology devices. To ensure we meet the needs of all families who need one, One (1) laptop will be distributed per family to those who do not have a computer at home. Loaned laptops will be returned to the district on May 31st, 2020, or upon request.

LAPTOP LOANING PROCEDURES

A parent/guardian must have the identification number (lunch number) of the OLDEST TESD student in the household. We thank you in advance for your patience with this process.

1. Families may pick-up a laptop from their child's school, using the last name initial of the OLDEST student in the household. We are asking that only families who do not have one of their own to borrow one.

2. Drive up to the pick-up station. Families will stay in the vehicle, drive-thru style.
3. Staff will fill-out a form with the information you will provide them, including the student ID number (lunch number) of the oldest student in the family.
4. Families will receive the laptop and additional information on how to connect from home.

To use the laptops, students will require connection to the Internet to access online learning. This can be done by using the home's Internet service such as Cox, Century Link or other similar provider. Most smart phones may be used to set-up a "Hot-Spot" that can provide Wi-Fi access to the Internet.
